Description: Small rocky island with little vegetation for cover. Rocky shoreline that allows close boat access.

Accessible by: Boat or canoe only

Description: Northwest side of Royal Baker Island. Good amount of vegetation. Site can be accessed on west and east side of island. Rocky shoreline with shallow water around the island.

Accessible by: Boat, canoe, or walk-in

Description: On the point about 15m from the treed area. Southeast of a small plot of vegetation, with little coverage. Rocky shoreline.
